1. The Government of Kenya (GOK) has received a loan from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) towards the cost to scale up the good results of the existing Smallholder Dairy Commercialization Programme (SDCP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
2. The consulting services (“the Services”) include to conducting an Impact Assessment Study. The programme intends to carry out a study on its outcomes and impacts. The Impact Assessment Study is expected to provide a clear assessment of programme achievements guided by the Development Assistance Committee (DAC) criteria of relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, impact on rural poverty, sustainability and innovation as well as lessons learnt. The consulting firm will prepare clear and acceptable impact and sustainability indicators based on programme goal and purposes. With regard to the programme goal, the study will assess the number of people whose lives have changed through increased incomes, and or taken out of poverty, and remain out of poverty from dairy

and dairy related activities. Clear measures of attribution in the assessment of effectiveness should be provided.

3. The Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Irrigation, State Department for Livestock, Smallholder Dairy Commercialization Programme (SDCP) now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services.
4. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:
 - 1) General experience of the firm (years’ of experience in consultancy services)
 - 2) Specific experience of the firm relevant to the proposed assignment
 - 3) References from clients on the previous assignments undertaken and relevant to the proposed assignment

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants (under IBRD loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers of January 2011 and revised in July 2014* (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

8. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.
9. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality cost based Selection method (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
