

## CONDITIONS FOR IMPORT AND EXPORT OF BIOLOGICAL MATERIALS

### A) Permit for export of biological materials (animal tissues, sera and cell culture)

- i. Applicant's details
- ii. Consigner details
- iii. Consignee details
- iv. Exporter details
- v. Details of the materials to be exported (Type and Viability of materials and their quantities, handling instructions)
- vi. The permit is valid for six months and will be used for only one consignment
- vii. End user declaration (That the biological materials shall only be used for diagnostic and research purposes only and will not be used for bioterrorism activities)
- viii. No objection permit from receiving government (The conditions issued by the receiving country)

Note: Packaging and transportation must be in accordance to IATA requirements for the transportation of biological materials hazardous to public health and livestock

### B) Permit for import of biological materials (animal tissues, sera and cell culture)

- i. Applicant's details
- ii. Consignee details
- iii. Importer details
- iv. Exporter details
- v. Consigner Details
- vi. Details of the material to be imported (Type and Viability of materials and their quantities, handling instructions)
- vii. The permit is valid for six months and will be used for only one consignment
- viii. End user declaration (That the biological materials shall only be used for diagnostic and research purposes only)

Note:

- a) This permit must be applied for at least two weeks before the shipment of the consignment
- b) Packaging and transportation must be in accordance to IATA requirements for the transportation of biological materials hazardous to public health and livestock.

### C) Permit for import hazardous material (chemicals and organisms)

- i. Applicant's details
- ii. Client's full address
- iii. Recipient's address
- iv. Details of the materials to be exported (Type and Viability of materials and their quantities, handling instructions)
- v. The permit is valid for six months and will be used for only one consignment

- vi. End user declaration (That the biological materials shall only be used for diagnostic and research purposes only and will not be used for bioterrorism activities)
- vii. Current retention of Registration certificate relevant from country of origin
- viii. Current registration and retention certificate in Kenya

Note: Packaging and transportation must be accordance to IATA requirements for the transportation of biological materials hazardous to public health and livestock.

Note that for transit permits all conditions apply and the cargo but the cargo shall be examined at the port of entry.
