

IMPORT CONDITIONS FOR FERTILE HATCHING EGGS INTO KENYA

1. The country of origin is free from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza and Low Pathogenic Avian Influenza;
2. The hatching eggs have come from establishments and/or hatcheries which are recognized as being free from avian infectious bronchitis and from hatcheries which comply with the standards referred to in OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
3. The hatching eggs have come from establishments and/or hatcheries which are recognized as being free from Infectious Laryngotracheitis and from hatcheries which comply with the standards referred to in OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
4. The hatching eggs have come from establishments free from avian mycoplasmosis and from hatcheries which comply with the standards referred to in OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
5. The hatching eggs come from establishments and/or hatcheries which are regularly inspected by the Veterinary Authority, AND come from establishments and/or hatcheries which are recognized as being free from avian tuberculosis.
6. The hatching eggs have come from establishments and/or hatcheries which are recognized as being free from fowl typhoid and pullorum disease and from hatcheries which comply with the standards referred to in OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
7. The hatching eggs have come from establishments in which vaccination against Marek's Disease is practised (the nature of the vaccine used and the date of vaccination shall also be stated in the certificate).
8. The hatching eggs came from an Newcastle Disease (ND) free country, zone or compartment, AND were derived from parent flocks which had been kept in an ND free country, zone or compartment for at least 21 days prior to and at the time of the collection of the eggs, AND if parent flocks were vaccinated against ND, the nature of the vaccine used and the date of vaccination should also be attached to the certificate.
9. The hatching eggs are transported in new or appropriately sanitized containers.
10. The hatching eggs were shipped in clean and unused packages.
11. This import permit must accompany the hatching eggs along with the international veterinary certificate
12. This permit is valid for **ninety days** and is for **one consignment only** but may be cancelled any time by the Director of Veterinary Services.
